Applying for Tuition Assistance

PEACE School is a registered charitable not-for-profit committed to admitting and enrolling students who desire and are suited to our enlightened academic and arts infused programs. As investors donate to PEACE School a Scholarship, Endowment and Bursary fund will be established. Tuition assistance is an option and is determined by merit, need and availability of funds. Our formula considers income, assets and expenses of both the parents and student (where applicable). The Admissions Committee uses all information to determine what a family might reasonably be able to contribute toward educational expenses. The Admissions Committee cannot grant tuition assistance award unless all requested documentation is submitted with a completed application.

How do I apply?

In order to be considered for tuition assistance, families must submit copies of their current tax forms and previous year's Notice of Assessment from Revenue Canada and a supplemental list of assets to include items such as land, cars, boats, second or more houses. Please ensure list clearly addresses any assets or income not listed elsewhere in the tuition assistance packet.

Will applying for Tuition Assistance affect our child's chances for admission?

No. The Admissions Committee makes decisions without regard to family financial circumstances. The School awards available partial or full scholarships to families who qualify for assistance. On occasion, when the family need is greater than the school's resources, some students may be placed on a waiting list until funds become available.

How does divorce or separation affect the process?

The Admissions Committee considers the financial resources of both parents and any stepparents. Both the custodial and non-custodial parents are required to complete Tuition Assistance application paperwork.

Will our child's Tuition Assistance award change from year to year?

Awards are made on a year-to-year basis. Families must re-apply annually if continued tuition assistance is sought.

Tuition Assistance Checklist

Note - All materials must be submitted with your completed application.

1. Letter to the school Admissions Committee indicating the amount being requested and why.
2. Supplemental Materials. Please provide the school with a packet containing:
 - a. Copies of Revenue Canada's Notice of Assessment for the current and previous years. (draft of Income Tax form initially acceptable for current year until official Notice of Assessment is available).
 - b. Supplemental list of assets / description of any assets or income that is not listed elsewhere in your Tuition Assistance application, and for families that own a business:
 - i. Balance sheet and Income statement
 - ii. Business tax forms – Notice of Assessment
